# TROUBLE SHOOTING GUIDE ROLLING GRILLES

## MANUAL PUSH-UP

#### Problem

Grille will not lift off floor

Grille stuck in ceiling - raised above stops

#### Solution

- \*Check that grille is fully unlocked
- \*If possible, work grille past stops one side at a time (call Dynaflair for service)

## **MOTORIZED**

#### Problem

Motor does not run

#### Solution

\*Check that gate is fully unlocked

\*Check circuit breakers on panel in store and re-set button on motor (see figure 2)

\*Check that emergency release is not engaged (see figure 1)

Motor runs but doors will not move

\*Check that gate is fully unlocked

\*Try helping door up as motor runs (call Dynaflair as soon as possible)

\*In emergency to either open or close – use emergency release lever or manual hand chain (see figure 1 and 2)

Gate was raised electrically while still locked and is not jammed:

From outside the store

\*Run door down as far as possible either by keyswitch, manual operation or forcing down at each end to unlock

From inside the store

\*Same as above and you can also try using the emergency release to lower grille (see figure 1)

\*In either case, call Dynaflair as soon as possible

### LOCKING

#### Problem

Cannot lock

Cannot unlock

#### Solution

- \*Push door down firmly to the floor checking for obstruction in guides.
- \*Check all cylinders are in unlocked positions and lever handle is down completely. (see figure 3)
- \*Push or run grille all the way down to un-jam rods
- \*Hold lever handle down firmly while turning key and then release to allow lever handle to pop up. (see figure 3)

## IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

## HOW TO OPEN DOOR MANUALLY FROM INTERIOR

- 1) Locate panic device, it should be on the same side as the motor about four feet off the floor, mounted in the wall.
- 2) Make sure the door is unlocked, if unable to unlock, refer to trouble shooting guide.
- 3) Pull panic device down and lock by shifting lever to the locking position. Door should pop up a few feet and/or door should be willing to raise up or down by lifting or pulling door.

## TO PUT BACK INTO NORMAL MOTOR OPERATION

- 1) Unlock panic device handle by shifting it to the original position.
- 2) Lift door up a few inches to lock in gears door can be operated again by motor.

## TO OPERATE MOTORIIZED DOOR BY HAND CHAIN

- 1) First, locate the access panel in the ceiling (near the motor). Use caution when opening access panel because dust and debris build up in the ceiling
- 2) Two chains should be visible, one smaller than the other.
- 3) Take the larger chain, this is the one that turns the inner motor, and shake it free so that if pulls freely.
- 4) Then take the smaller chain, this is the chain that locks the motor into manual operation, and pull down hard as you turn the larger chain.
- 5) The smaller chain must be held down continuously while pulling the other chain in the desired direction. This operation normally requires two people.
